I. Add Staff in Critical High-Need Areas - \$2,000,000

Targeted areas:

- Experience highest rates of foster care entries
- Have more than 300 children without a CASA advocate
- Contain 7 affiliates serving 28 counties and nearly 5,000 children (30% of total children in foster care)
- Need 40 paid staff positions to support additional 1,000 volunteers

Need categories:

Augusta & Columbus Areas

Augusta Area

- 811 children in care
- 53% without CASA advocate
- 6 new staff

Columbus Area

- 558 children in care
- 67% without CASA advocate
- 4 new staff

Extreme Need

Waycross & Lookout Mountain

Lookout Mountain

- 494 children in care
- 88% without CASA advocate
- 5 new staff

Waycross Area

- 821 children in care
- 66% without CASA advocate
- 6 new staff

Sheer Volume Dekalb Dekalb • 838 children in care • 35% without CASA advocate • 4 new staff

Expansion in Untapped Areas Gwinnett & Cobb

Gwinnett

- 604 children in care
- 92% without CASA advocate
- 7 new staff

Cobb

- 650 children in care
- 66% without CASA advocate
- 6 new staff

II. Expand Network Growth & Sustained Service - \$750,000

- Increase affiliate service levels to address heightened demand and volunteer availability
- · Continue coordinated training, statewide recruitment, screening, and quality assurance efforts
