

In a given year, an average of over 1,000 contacts with affiliates are made by the Georgia CASA team via phone calls, emails, visits, and statewide events.




Map current as of June 30, 2022

### **Quality Volunteer Advocacy**

Provided statewide trainings, on-site court visits, affiliate-focused advocacy reviews, and individualized case consultations in the areas of child welfare law, policy, and practice

Delivered these supports and resources statewide to more than 3,000 staff and advocates, designed to promote strengthened CASA volunteer and staff advocacy skills and effectiveness both within and beyond courtroom

#### FEATURE: Advancing Advocacy Webinars

· Launched monthly Advancing Advocacy webinars for hundreds of CASA staff and volunteers to strengthen quality of best interest advocacy across state and make connections with experts to meet needs of children and families

 Topics included trauma-informed advocacy, reunification, commercial sexual exploitation of children, Medicaid waivers, and supports and services for immigrant children among many others

### **Affiliate Operations**

Comprehensive support and services provided to improve quality advocacy and effectiveness, including visits, trainings, networking opportunities, and consultation in a variety of operational areas

Facilitation of 60+ trainings and small group discussions in addition to 10 larger core trainings, State Conference, and routine calls and meet-ups

Included nine Race Equity Diversity Inclusion (REDI) related meetings, eight director meetings to discuss trends and issues, two Council of Programs meetings and 30 Affinity Group discussions

### **Recruitment & Awareness**

Created and disseminated a variety of volunteer recruitment and awareness materials and tools to affliates, as well as offered consultation and technical assistance on recruitment. Further promoted CASA mission via people recognition opportunities and various communications tools including website, social media channels, and e-newsletters

- · Georgia campaign ads ran in Atlanta and Macon designated market areas during Fall 2021 (social media, digital out-of-home, digital newspapers & radio)
- 8.9 million total impressions / 1,000+ volunteer inquiries to Georgia CASA
- National campaign ads ran at Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport in Atlanta (ongoing)







### Legislative & Policy Advocacy

Tracked and supported key legislative issues impacting children and families involved in child welfare and coordinated legislatives activities and outreach

#### FEATURE: CASA Day at the Capitol - February 2022

- Day included on-site and virtual legislative briefing
- Legislative appointments, both in-person or virtually, during legislative session
- CASA materials distributed on-site to each legislator's office

At close of legislative session, General Assembly increased the State of Georgia's investment by \$200,000 for total of \$3.82 million for CASA advocacy statewide
