The Solution: Citizen Volunteers

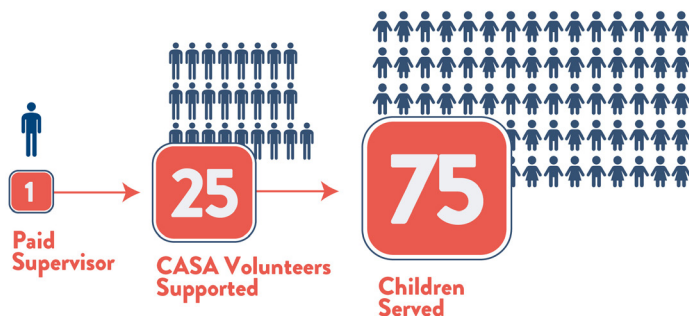
Trained CASA volunteers advocate for the best interests of Georgia's children in foster care.
