We hope you're making plans to attend CASA Day at the Capitol on Thursday. We are excited that the legislators will be at the Capitol for Legislative Day 18. To maximize your chances of connecting with your elected officials, find the legislators that represent your CASA program's service area using the member contact sheets, try to schedule an appointment, and invite your legislators to our drop-in luncheon. You can also plan to page them at the ropes or coordinate to meet up at a specific time for a photo, sighting, etc.

In addition to the legislators, Georgia CASA board members, and CASA attendees, a few of our partners and state policy advocates who will be at the Capitol will be joining us as well.

This will be covered in the *Know Before You Go* email, but there is parking that is connected to the Twin Towers at the Pete Hackney Parking Garage. \$10 on entry. Please allow time and be prepared for a 15-minute (covered) walk to the event venue. Don't forget your ID. You will need it multiple times for security.
